


### Tourism in Georgia Monthly Market Watch

## Sep-19: total arrivals up 2.7% y/y, tourists up 0.6% y/y

# International visitors (tourists and same-day) by type




- In Sep-19, total international visitors (tourists and same-day combined) were up 2.7% y/y to 0.78mn persons. Out of total, Georgia hosted 0.53mn tourists (up 0.6% y/y) and 0.24mn sameday visitors (up 7.7% y/y) in September.
- Slow arrival growth in September like in two previous months reflected significantly reduced arrivals from largest source markets - Russia and Iran.
- Notably, due to last year's high base, arrivals from Russia reduced sharper (-20.6% y/y) in Sep-19 compared to two previous months (-7.6% y/y).
- Meanwhile, arrivals from all other neighbors (Azerbaijan, Armenia and Turkey) continued growing. Notably, arrivals from Turkey are on the rise since Jun-19 after falling from Sep-18 to May-19.
- From non-neighboring markets, visitors from EU, Ukraine, Israel, Saudi Arabia and Kazakhstan continue travelling to Georgia in rising numbers. Notably, visitors from the EU were up 26.7% y/y to over 72k visitors, with UK (+43.4% y/y) Germany (+39.3% y/y) and Poland (+22.5% y/y) driving growth.
- In 9M19, total international arrivals stood at c.6.0mn persons (up 5.9% y/y), of which tourist arrivals reached 4.0mn, up 5.8% y/y.
- Based on statements of the Russian government representatives, direct flights from Russia to Georgia might resume soon.

# International visitors (tourists and same-day) by country



### Total international visitors stood at 5.98 mn (+5.9% y/y) persons in 9M19:

- From top markets, Russia was the largest contributor to arrival growth (due to strong growth in 1H19), followed by Azerbaijan and Armenia.
- Visitors from EU increased 24.1% y/y to over 385k persons

#### In 9M19:

- Tourist trips increased 5.8% y/y, accounting for 66.7% of total arrivals, down 0.1ppts y/y.
- Same-day arrivals were up 6.2% y/y, as arrivals from Turkey turned positive after falling during Sep-18 to May-19




## Expectations for 2019

• We forecast 1mn tourists to visit Georgia in 4Q19 bringing total tourist arrivals to 5mn persons (+5.2% y/y) in 2019.

• We forecast tourism revenues at US\$ 3.4n (+4.3% y/y) in 2019 vs. our initial forecast of US\$ 3.6bn (+12.3% y/y).
